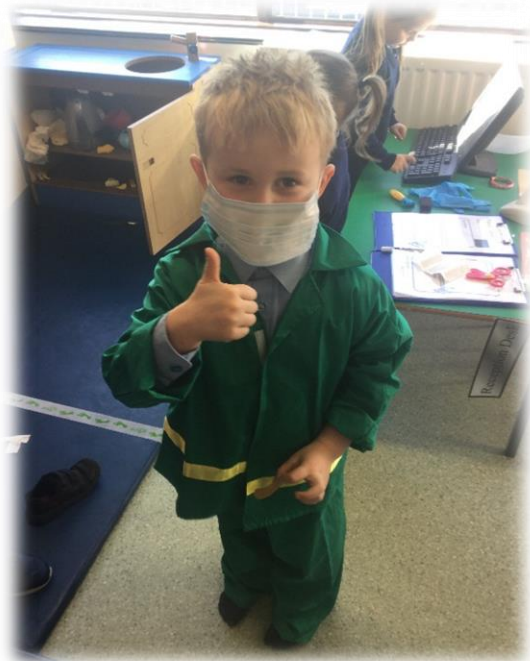

Higgins will teach me at school too.



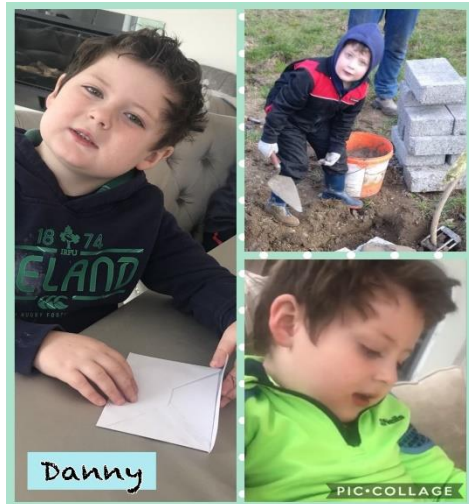
I have to complete some work in my yellow and green task boxes each day.
